Let us take you away from the normal for you to experience life without worry. Your holiday has been planned by our experienced team so you can sit back, relax and let the worries of the world go away for a while.

From trains to stately homes, gardens, adult only holidays and 5-star cruises supplied by Ambassador Cruise Lines, we have a selection of breaks for everyone to enjoy.

Remember if you are a single traveller, we do recommend you book early. We offer a certain number of single rooms without supplement on each UK, hotel-based tour. Once these have been booked single rooms will be subject to availability and will incur a supplement, even if they are true singles.

For the new single traveller, booking may feel like a daunting prospect. If you have seen a holiday you think you will enjoy, please don't hesitate to call us with any questions you may have. Our office is staffed Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm and if you need to contact us in an emergency, our office number 01507-463000 is answered all day every day.

If you have any special dietary requirements or need a little help with access in your room such as a step-in shower (where available) or level access, you can ask on booking and we will endeavour to find you the perfect room. (Special requests can never be 100% guaranteed but we do our best in all circumstances to help) Upgraded rooms are subject to availability and always incur a supplement from the hotel.

I am a true believer in 'if you don't ask, you don't get', something my nan said when I was small

and she did regret the onslaught of questions from me, but I learnt an awful lot. I learnt that no question is a daft question and if I don't know the answer, I can usually find it for you.

Coach access: You must be able to board the coach. If you think you may have difficulty, we can arrange for you to come down to our depot in Alford and see how you go. These appointments are subject to availability and do not include a tour of the depot.

Walking aids are welcome on board. However there are some limitations as to what we are capable of transporting, so I have put together a comprehensive guide (below).

Maximum weight limit 15kg per item

Please ensure you notify us on booking your intention to travel with any of the following items.

Walking Sticks

These can be taken on board the coach.

Walkers/Rollators

Walkers and rollators are welcome. They will be folded and stored in the boot of the coach and your driver will help with loading.

Wheelchair (manual)

Manual wheelchairs are welcome. They will be folded and stored in the boot of the coach, your driver will help with loading.

Wheelchair (electric)

Electric wheelchairs must fold flat and be 15kg or less. Drivers are not permitted to help with loading, so you must travel with someone who can. Only 1 per tour due to weight restrictions.

Scooter (electric)

Electric mobility scooters must fold flat and be 15kg or less. Drivers are not permitted to help with loading, so you must travel with someone who can. Only 1 per tour, due to weight restrictions.

Zimmer Frame

These can be stored in the boot of the coach and your driver will help with loading.

Shopping Trolleys

These are not disability aids, we can only assess the space in the boot at the time. Drivers will not assist with loading so you must travel with someone who can load and unload your trolley. Contents are stored in the boot at your own risk.

If your intention to travel with any of these items is not mentioned on booking, or as soon as you possibly can before travel, we reserve the right to refuse the item on boarding.

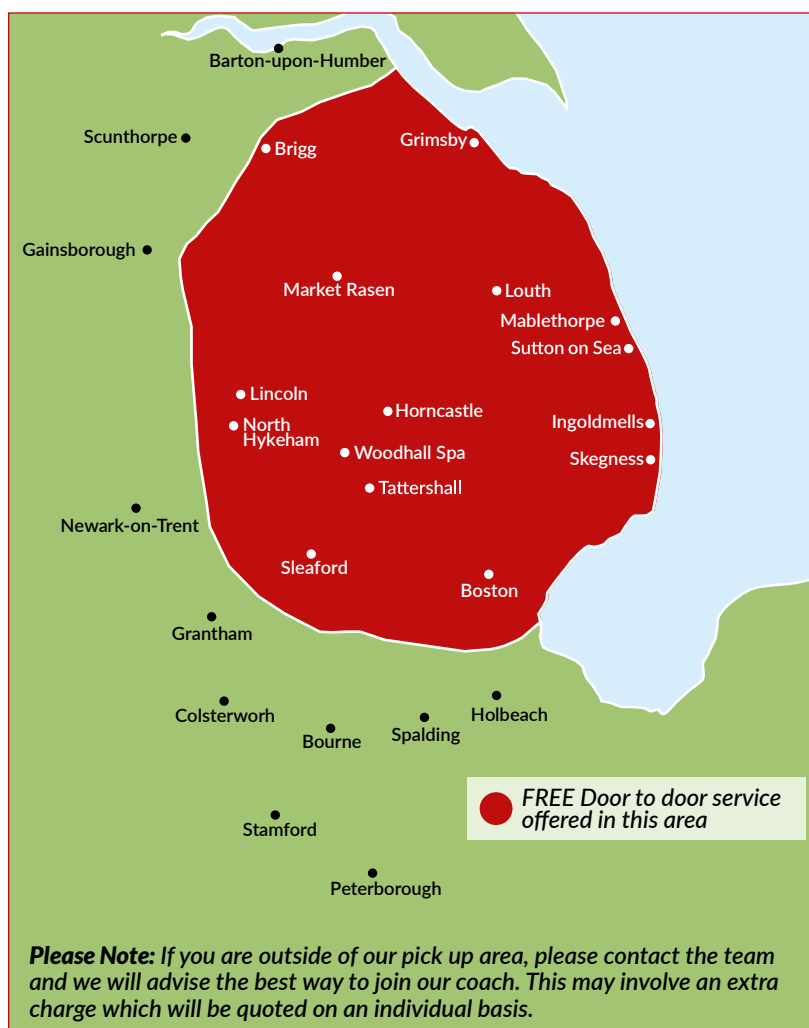

We will use a mixture of our own vehicles and taxi services to pick you up and take you to meet the coach. If you live outside the main pick up area, please give us a call, we will do our best to arrange transport for you (This may incur a small surcharge). Transport from your home within our large catchment area is included in all of our brochured tours, except overnight stays, for which we offer a selection of pick up points. We appreciate that Lincolnshire is a large rural County, therefore we understand that some of our passengers rely on this service and would not be able to travel without it. However we also appreciate some passengers who have their own transport may not wish to take a less direct route. We have a large free car park at our Alford depot where we are happy for you to leave your car for the duration of your tour.

Your trip begins when you contact our travel office where our friendly and experienced office staff are able to guide you through the booking process and deal with any queries you may have. The office is open Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm (excluding bank holidays) and the office number, **01507 463000** is answered out of hours, for emergencies only.

Reserved Coach Seating

When you make a booking, you will be allocated seat numbers on the coach, which will remain yours for the duration of the tour. Requests for specific seat numbers can be made, but as bookings are made on a first come first served basis, we recommend you book early to avoid disappointment. On page 2 you will find the seating plans for our various coaches. Use this to help choose your seats. Coaches will be allocated nearer the time and you will be contacted as soon as possible to confirm changes should your allocated seats be affected.

Travel Documents

Upon receipt of your payment you will be issued with confirmation of your booking, or, if you have booked online your documents will be emailed to you. Please check these documents carefully and contact the office immediately if you think anything will require amending. Certain documents such as entry tickets will be given to you by the driver on the day.

Luggage

We would ask on all overnight stays and holidays you only bring one medium sized suitcase (max weight 15kg) per person plus one piece of hand luggage. Overnight stays do not include portage unless otherwise stated. We recommend taking a small carry on bag on these occasions.

Hotel Accommodation

Accommodation featured in this brochure varies from luxurious 4* establishments to homely family run hotels. We make every effort to ensure that all accommodation is of an acceptable standard and you are allocated precisely the kind of room you have requested. Although all special requests are not guaranteed, we do our best to accommodate. When booking for 2 people sharing a room you should either request a double or twin beds. Single rooms are always in high demand and early booking is recommended. Holidays which offer single rooms without a supplement are limited. Once these rooms have sold, and we request additional rooms over our

allocation. A supplement may apply on a tour which has advertised no single room supplement. Some hotels release Double or twin bedded rooms and some issue true single rooms but still charge the supplement. This is something we do not agree with, but we have no control over.

Meals

Full Board: Breakfast, Lunch and evening meal included

All inclusive: Meals and selected drinks are included in your holiday.

Half Board: Breakfast and evening meal included

Bed & breakfast: Breakfast is supplied on this holiday (such as London) but no evening meal.

Seatbelts

In line with legislation, seatbelts must always be worn when travelling on the coach. Seatbelt extensions are available if required and must be ordered when making your booking.

Special Needs/Access Requirements

We try to ensure all of our holidays are as disability friendly as they can be. If you have any special access requirements or require special assistance in any way, please mention this at the time of booking. All visitor attractions and hotels will provide access statements to us/you on request.

24 Hours Emergency Contact

In case of an emergency either prior to collection or during your holiday, you can contact the usual office number **01507 463000** where you will be diverted to an out of hours mobile. Please note, any non emergencies will not be dealt with out of usual office hours and you will be asked to call back.

Lost Property

Any items of lost property which are found on our coaches will be handed in to our traffic office as soon as possible, where it will be available for collection. Please report lost items by calling the office on **01507 463000**

Concerts, Shows, Special offers and Tours.

We are continuously releasing additional information on concerts, shows and late availabilities which are not listed in this brochure. Please either go online at www.hunts-coaches.co.uk for updates or call in to the travel office for details. We also offer an extensive day excursion brochure which will be released in March. Please check pages 30 and 31 of the holiday brochure for a preview.

Pick Up Points / Home Pick Up

You are responsible for being at the correct departure point at the correct time with the correct documents. We cannot be held responsible for any loss or expense suffered by passengers due to their late arrival. Door

to Door pick ups will be provided on holidays 2+ nights within our Large Lincolnshire area as per the map on page 4. We may use our own minibuses, cars or external taxi companies to get you to the nearest point to meet the main coach on its journey. In rare cases this may mean you are onboard the feeder for more than an hour, as you will be collected with everyone else in your area. We do try our best to minimise the journey. A large car park is provided at our depot in Alford if you wish to meet the coach yourself.

Passenger Behaviour

We want all of our passengers to have a happy and carefree holiday. We reserve the right to terminate a clients booking in the event of unreasonable conduct which in our opinion is likely to cause damage, stress or danger or annoyance to any other clients, employees or third parties. If you are prevented from travelling or continuing your excursion by such termination, our responsibility to you ceases and we will be under no obligation for any refund, compensation or loss you may incur.

Carriage of Wheelchairs and Scooters

Our policy is to assist with the handling of fold up manual wheelchairs or walkers for those who are disabled, but we can only carry lightweight foldable wheelchairs or walkers in the luggage compartment of the coach at your own risk (see page 3). Any passenger wishing to take a wheelchair or walker should inform us during the booking process so we can ensure space is reserved for transportation. Passengers travelling with these items must be able to assemble/ dismantle them or be travelling with someone who can. We can accept one electric scooter per tour which must weigh less than 15kg with the battery removed during transport. You must inform us on booking. We reserve the right to refuse any scooters which we believe do not fulfil the criteria for transport. The driver will not be able to help you with the loading or offloading of the scooter from the boot of the coach, so you must travel with someone who can.

Making a Complaint

If you have a complaint whilst on your holiday, please inform in the first instance your driver immediately who will do their best to solve the problem. If you are still unhappy then call the travel office on **01507 463000** and we will do our best to put things right. If you are still not satisfied on return, you must notify us in writing within 14 days of the completion of your tour. Failure to establish a complaint in accordance with the above procedure may affect the outcome of it. Whilst we endeavour to ensure that all the information contained in our brochure is accurate, we cannot be held responsible for any omissions or errors included in it and we reserve the right to change the itinerary in the rare case that we have to.
